

Kentucky Youth Anglers League

Scoring, Points, Championship, and Top Angler Advancement

- A. Qualifier Scoring
 - a. Placement in a Qualifying Event (Q.E.) will be determined by the following:
 - i. Team with the heaviest, 3 fish limit.
 - 1. Tiebreaker
 - a. Least number of dead fish
 - b. Heaviest fish. Must be alive.
 - c. Coin toss by Tournament Director.
- B. Points
 - a. 1st place receives 200 points, 2nd - 199, 3rd - 198, etc.
 - b. Points do not cross from Varsity to J.V. and vice-versa.
 - c. For all advancement and awards each team will be allowed to discard one of the five Q.E.s.
 - d. Club of the Year will be determined by a club's three best performing teams in the Team of the Year standings.
- C. Championship Qualification and Format
 - a. Varsity - Two Day event.
 - i. Up to the top fifty percent (50%) in Team of the Year points who have weighed fish during a Q.E. will advance.
 - ii. Teams must finish in the top fifty percent after Day 1 to advance to Day 2.
 - iii. Weights are combined for both days.
 - b. Junior Varsity - One Day event
 - i. Any team weighing fish at a Q.E. will advance.
 - c. Boat numbers for day 1 of the championship will be determined by T.O.Y . points. Day two boat numbers will be determined by day 1 placement.
- D. Top Angler
 - a. The top ten (10) teams from the Varsity Championship will be split into single anglers to determine the Top Angler Title. This will take place the first Sunday following Championship Saturday. All Varsity rules will apply.
 - b. Each individual angler must provide themselves with a boat captain (and spectator if needed).
 - c. Boat numbers will be determined by placement in the Championship and a coin toss between teammates.
